Your tour of **Buffalo Trace** will include walking amidst the path of rolling bourbon barrels, watching the hand packaging of signature bourbons, an engaging video of the distillery's history and a complimentary tasting of some of **Buffalo Trace's** award-winning bourbon.

For lunch you're met with a warm welcome at the **Holly Hill Inn**, a charming restaurant in the heart of Bluegrass Horse Country. The Inn, built circa 1845, offers fine dining in an historic country setting. Select from a three-course pre-fix menu prepared by Chef Ouita Michel. Chef Ouita has been a James Beard Foundation Award nominee as Outstanding Restaurateur and as Best Chef Southeast numerous times, competing against chefs in major metropolitan areas. Your lunch may consist of seasonal prix fix items such as Bibb Lettuce Salad with Green Goddess Dressing, a Traditional Kentucky Hot Brown or Chicken Scaloppini and Jamieson's Chocolate Bread Pudding smothered in Bourbon Sauce!



Once your appetite is sated it's off to **Wild Turkey Distillery**. For more than 200 years, Kentucky's legendary distilleries have crafted the world's finest Bourbons, using secret recipes and a time-honored process passed down from generation to generation. You'll traverse the beautiful Bluegrass Countryside to reach the **Wild Turkey Distillery**. Nestled outside Lawrenceburg near the Kentucky River Gorge is the new \$4 million dollar Wild Turkey Visitors' Center. Here you'll learn the history of bourbon, see production at the recently expanded distillery and enjoy a tasting of **Wild Turkey Bourbon**.
